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



### CONNECTED NEBRASKA OFFERS FREE WIRELESS INTERNET TO NEBRASKA SCHOOLS

The Nebraska Department of Education (NDE), the Office of the Chief Information Officer, Network Nebraska, and the University of Nebraska unveiled ConnectEd Nebraska, a new educational internet program for Nebraska K-12 schools. This program is powered by eduroam and provides students and educators with free and readily available access to guest wireless networks at participating ConnectEd Nebraska eduroam schools.


ConnectEd Nebraska is currently funded by Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act money and free to Nebraska school districts for three years. "In the spring of 2020, the NDE administered a public survey designed to prioritize Covid-19 relief funds in a way that most benefits Nebraska students, families, and school communities," said Commissioner Matthew Blomstedt. 




#### Distinct device activity over the last twelve months






Why K-12 schools, libraries, and museums are different than your traditional HE eduroam deployment




## Issues unique to K-12 Schools

# Radius Server Types








